Disappeared victims, relatives on one stage at publication festival in collaboration with DUCSU

The victims of enforced disappearances and their relatives gathered on one stage at a publication festival organized by the Dhaka University Central Students' Union (DUCSU) and Prachin Prakash.

On Saturday at 10 am, the launch ceremony of the book 'Ainagharer Sakshi: Guni Jibon Aat Bhaat' written by Barrister Mir Ahmad Bin Kashem (Arman) and a seminar titled 'Disappearance is the worst tool of fascist rule' were held at the Sheikh Mujibur.

Speaking as a special guest at the event, Adilur Rahman Khan, Advisor to the Ministry of Housing and Public Works, said: "The fascist regime had imprisoned the entire Bangladesh. The days of extrajudicial killings are over, now we are moving towards establishing the rule of law. The trial of the criminals has begun. Injustice will end and the people of Bangladesh and the oppressed will get justice. Bangladesh will be transformed into a new Bangladesh based on the July Declaration and the July Charter. This struggle is ongoing and this fight is for the future of the future. Even if fascism is defeated, it tries to come back again and again, so despite our differences, we all have to continue the struggle to resist fascism in unity."

DUCSU Vice President (VP) Sadiq Kayem said at the event, "The murderer Hasina has used the administrative institutions of the state to abduct and murder anti-fascists. We have recovered some of the victims of the July Revolution, including Barrister Arman Bhai, Humam Quader Chowdhury Bhai. But we still do not know where Ismail Chhara Shihir leader Obulullah, BNP's (Ilias Ali, and Sumon Bhai are. Just as the Nazi army was banned in Germany and Mussolini was banned in Italy, similarly in Bangladesh, the Awami League, Chhatra League, Juba League, and the friends of the murderer Hasina have no right to do politics. They should be taken to the police station wherever they are found and brought to exemplary justice."

Mother's Call Coordinator Sanjida Islam Tuli said, the book 'Ainagharer Sakshi' has brought to the fore the horrific reality of disappearances and torture. Electric shocks in small detention cells, torture by hanging, lethal injection, throwing on railway tracks, taking them to the Hariganga-Shitalakha rivers or other places, leaving their stomachs and weighing them down with cement bags, these were brutal tools of the fascist regime.
