- Applicants must have Bachelor degree in any discipline from any recognized university.
- Applicants must have at least 2<sup>nd</sup> class (or CGPA 2.50) in all examinations.
- The complete application package includes: (A) a filled in application form (B) four passport size photos and a copy of NID of the applicant; (C) copies of all academic certificates and mark sheets/transcripts; (D) professional experience certificate/s (if any)
- Incomplete applications will not be processed.
- The merit list of candidates for admission into the PMPCHR programme will be prepared based on a score earned out of 100 marks.
- The written admission test will carry 85 marks divided into three sections: (1) History and culture of Bangladesh (In Bengali) (2) Current affairs of Bangladesh (In English) (3) International Affairs (In English) Viva Voce will carry 15 marks.
- The duration of the written admission test is 1:30 hours.
- Regarding admission, the decision of the **Department of Peace and Conflict Studies, University of Dhaka** will be final.
